## Boys Football Team

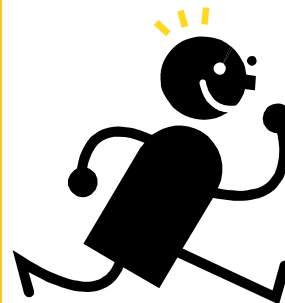
