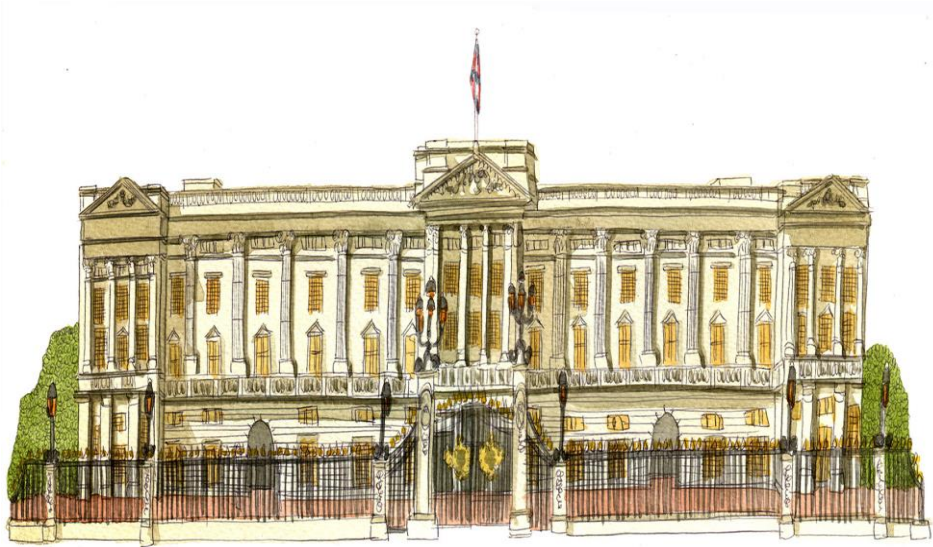

Itinerary

Day 1 (Monday 25th June)

Arrive at Penzance Train Station for 8.40 a.m. Parents say goodbye to children and leave by 8.45a.m. to enable register to be taken and get organised on the train. (remember to bring a packed lunch and drink bottles x2) Train departs at 9.00 a.m.

Arrive in London at 2.00p.m.

Eat out at Smollensky's, evening attraction will be a visit to Leicester Square.

Day 2 (Tuesday 26th June)

Palace of Westminster Tour & Workshop. Further sightseeing - 10 Downing Street and neighbouring attractions.

This will be followed by a Thames River Cruise.

Evening meal will be at TGI Fridays (Leicester Square) followed by the London Eye.

Day 3 (Wednesday 27th June)

Visit to the Imperial War Museum Science Museum and Buckingham Palace.

Evening meal will be at Belgo Centraal (Covent Garden) followed by theatre trip "School of Rock" (Drury Lane)

Day 4 (Thursday 28th June)

The morning will be spent in Covent Garden watching the street performers and visiting the shops. Then return to hotel to collect suitcases. Catch the tube to Paddington for the 14.00 to Penzance, arriving at 19.20



Equipment List

Bedding is provided and includes a duvet, duvet cover, sheet, pillows and pillow cases.

- Suitable clothing, for all activities, and footwear for lots of walking around London. (think of a typical British Summer in terms of weather...)
- Nightwear/slippers (teddy bear?)
- Sun Cream
- Toiletries – toothbrush/toothpaste, soap/shampoo, brush/comb & towel
- Packed lunch and bottles x2 for journey to London (we will reuse the container and bottles each day)
- Day-bag / rucksack or shoulder bag to put the above items in
- Plastic bin liner for dirty washing
- Camera (Responsibility of the child. Photos not to be uploaded to social media sites/internet).
- Spending Money £30.00 recommended. (Child's responsibility).
- Any medication needed (to be labelled and passed to Mrs.Barr before we depart).
- Reading material/small electronic hand held games but nothing with internet/wifi capability.
- **No** Mobile phones/ipads
- Compact game(s) top trumps, solitaire etc.
