Well done to **INDIGO** & **VIOLET** class for having the **BEST** attendance figure for last week!

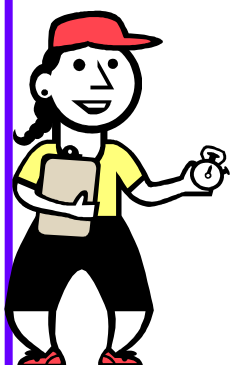
