Introduction

This booklet has the information you need to complete an application for a school place in September 2024 in Reception, Year 3 of a Junior School or Year 7.

Cornwall Council handles applications for all schools in Cornwall using a process set out in the 'Co-ordinated Admissions Scheme'. The Scheme can be found at: www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions or you can ask us for a copy.

The process is explained in this booklet.

Cornwall Council and schools must follow the School Admissions Code 2021.

Which children

Starting School

- Applying for a place in a reception class.
- For children born between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020.
- You can find out more about when children have to start school in the 'About Starting School' section.
- If your child attends a school's nursery or pre-school class you still need to apply.

Transfer to Junior School

- Applying for a place in year three at a junior school. This is the first year of a junior school.
- For children born between 1 September 2016 and 31 August 2017.
- For children who need to transfer from Year 2 in an infant school to Year 3 in a junior school and children who live in Cornwall and attend a primary school who want a place in Year 3 at a junior school.
- Children normally start in year three at a junior school in the September following their seventh birthday.
- If you want to apply for a primary school instead of a junior school you will need to complete a different application form. The application will be processed later than junior school applications. Contact the School Admissions Team for more information.

Transfer to Secondary School

- Applying for a place in year seven at a secondary school.
- For children born between 1 September 2012 and 31 August 2013.
- Children normally transfer to secondary school in the September following their eleventh birthday.

Children with an Education, Health and Care Plan

If your child has an Education, Health and Care (EHC) Plan you do not need to complete an application form.

Please contact the Statutory SEN Service (01872 324242) for more information.

Education outside the normal age group

Decisions about children being educated outside their normal age group are made by the school's admission authority. Decisions must be made on a case by case basis. For more information go to the 'Deferring or delaying admission to school and educating pupils out of their chronological year group' page at www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions or contact the School Admissions Team for more information.

Where to submit your application

You need to apply to your home local authority for a place.

I live in Cornwall

- You need to apply to Cornwall Council for your preferred schools even if one (or more) is not in Cornwall. You should also contact the schools for details of any other information that they may need from you.

I live outside Cornwall

- If you want to apply for a school in Cornwall you have to apply through your home local authority. See later in this booklet for information on the home address.

I am moving to Cornwall

- If you want to apply for a school in Cornwall because you will be moving you have to apply through your home local authority. You will need a confirmed address. See later in this booklet for information on the home address.

I live overseas

- If you live overseas but are planning to move to Cornwall you can apply direct to Cornwall Council.

Deciding which schools

You can apply for up to three schools.

Before you decide which schools to apply for you could:

- arrange a visit by contacting the school;
- have a look at the school's website;
- ask for a copy of their prospectus.

You should also...

Read the school's oversubscription criteria

This will help you understand how places will be allocated.

Find out if your child would be eligible for travel assistance

You should not assume that your child is eligible for home to school travel assistance. If you wish to check your eligibility please contact the Transport Coordination Service **before submitting your application**.

See the Home to School Travel Assistance section later in this booklet for more information.

Name more than one preference including your nearest school/s

If you only put one preference and we cannot offer you that school you might be allocated a school some distance away as other parents/carers who did express additional preferences will take priority for the nearer schools.

Naming more than one preference will not give you any less chance of getting a place at your preferred school.

Designated areas

Cornwall Council has divided Cornwall into areas called 'designated areas'. You might also hear them called 'catchment' areas. These are each served by a specific school or schools.

- Your designated school may not be the one nearest to your home address.
- Some schools include living in the designated area as a priority in their oversubscription criteria. This is the criteria they will use to decide who should have a place.
- Entitlement to travel assistance to **all** schools will be decided by Cornwall Council based on whether or not:
 - your address is in the school's designated area; or
 - it is your nearest school.
- If you want to find the designated or nearest school or schools for your address:
 - go to www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions; or
 - contact the School Admissions Team.

Home address

We can only use one address to process your application.

- A child can only have one address which will be used to decide:
 - admission to school; and
 - home to school travel assistance entitlement.
- The address must be:
 - the child's principal permanent residence at the point of application and the address from which they will attend school; or
 - a future address from which the child will attend school, supported by a form of evidence.
- An admission authority may refuse to accept an address if an applicant still owns or rents an address at which their child previously lived. It is for the admission authority to decide:
 - if the address given on an application is a child's current or future principal permanent residence and the address from which they will attend school; and
 - which address should be used to decide eligibility for a place.
- We would need evidence of a proposed address in the form of, for example:
 - a signed rental agreement; or

- evidence of an exchange of contracts.

Other forms of evidence are listed in the Co-ordinated Admissions Scheme which can be found on the website: www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions

- Exceptional circumstances in relation to the provision of a home address will be considered on a case by case basis. If there is shared residence of the child or a query is raised regarding the validity of an address, Cornwall Council will consider the home address to be with the parent with primary day to day care and control of the child. Residency of a child may also be clarified through a child arrangement order where it is shown who has care of the child. Evidence may be requested to show where the child lives.
- If there is a disagreement between parents/carers about the home address:
 - You should sort this out before applying.
 - You may need to get legal advice.
 - The Council or the admission authority will decide which address to use if you cannot agree or do not tell us in time.

Home to School Travel Assistance

Eligibility for free travel assistance is assessed separately from admission to school.

- You should not assume that your child is eligible for travel assistance. If you wish to check your child's eligibility, please contact the Transport Co-ordination Service before submitting your school place application.
- Please be advised that there are planned changes which will mean that travel assistance currently in place for some school children will not be available to children starting school in September 2024. It is suggested that parents take these changes into account when applying for school places. Further details on the planned changes can be found via www.cornwall.gov.uk/schooltransport
- Some children may be entitled to travel assistance provided by Cornwall Council.
 - You are responsible for ensuring your child attends school regularly. This includes applying for travel assistance and/or accompanying your child when walking to and from school, where possible.
 - The eligibility criteria are explained in **Cornwall's Home to School Travel Assistance Policy**. You can read this at: www.cornwall.gov.uk/schooltransport.
 - Whilst feeder/designated schools may be used for the allocation of places by the School Admissions Team, they are not recognised for the purposes of determining eligibility for travel assistance.
 - If eligible, travel assistance will be provided via the most cost-effective suitable method.
 - The standard method of travel for children of **primary school age** is a taxi or minibus, shared with other children.
 - The standard method of travel for children of **secondary school age** is a travel pass for public transport or a school bus (under closed contract to the Local Authority).
 - If eligible, travel assistance will only be provided at the official beginning and end of the school day.

Sustainable travel to school

Cornwall Council is fully committed to promoting walking, cycling, public transport (if available) and car sharing for the school journey. We would like as many children to walk or cycle to school as possible instead of being driven by an adult. Enabling the increased use of sustainable modes of travel such as walking, cycling and the use of public transport has environmental benefits in reducing levels of noise, congestion and poor air quality.

Service Families (UK Armed Forces)

There are certain procedures to help remove disadvantage for Service Families.

Service Families:

- are more likely to need to apply when schools may already be full; and
- may be unable to provide a specific address in time for the admissions process.

The Armed Forces Covenant tries to make sure that the service community is not disadvantaged.

There are some specific references to Service Children in the School Admissions Code. It should be noted that:

- the Covenant does not seek preferential treatment for the service community; and
- the School Admissions Code does not give Service Children any automatic right to a place in their preferred school.

Applications will be processed and places allocated:

- based on the proposed address with supporting evidence; **or**
- if you are not able to confirm a proposed address and a unit or quartering address is provided, an allocation will be made based on the **unit or quartering address**.

This is to ensure that your child is not left without a school place, although it is accepted that you may want/need to change your preference when a new address is confirmed in order to try to secure a school closer to that address. The School Admissions Team will then offer support and guidance.

Special Educational Needs

If your child has an Education, Health and Care (EHC) plan you are **not required** to make an application.

- School admissions for children with an EHC plan are arranged by the Statutory SEN Service, outside the Co-ordinated Admissions Scheme.
- Admission for these children will be handled in accordance with the national SEND Code of Practice and associated regulations.

When parents/carers disagree about an application

Only one application can be processed for each child.

- You should sort out any disagreement before applying.
- We can only offer one school place.

If there is a disagreement about the application or the preferences, either by someone disputing an application or by two applications being submitted:

- You will need to agree or settle the matter through the courts.
- Cornwall Council will decide which application to process if you do not agree or get a court order in time for us to be able to allocate a place within the timescales.

We will take into account the following:

- your child's home address;
- the living arrangements;
- your child's view;
- what is considered to be in the child's best interests;
- other relevant factors.

Fraudulent applications

You could miss out on your preferred school if you submit a fraudulent application.

- A fraudulent application is one where the applicant uses false information to gain advantage in the application process.
- If you use false or misleading information in your application which may gain you advantage over other applicants we might:
 - start an investigation which could lead to criminal proceedings;
 - ask you to provide evidence to help with an investigation;
 - share your information to help with preventing and detecting fraud;
 - withdraw the offer of a school place.
- You must tell us immediately if your circumstances change.
- We carry out checks on a random sample of applications to ensure that the address information is accurate. This is to ensure that places are allocated fairly. If you are randomly selected you will receive a letter requesting evidence of your current address. We may also request evidence where we are alerted to a potential false address.

About starting school in reception

Most children start reception at the same time. There are also options for starting later.

- Places in reception will be allocated as full-time.
- You can request part-time admission until your child reaches compulsory school age. You need to arrange this with the school.
- When a child starts in a reception class at school, nursery funding will not be paid from that term. Any free entitlement will be used within the school budget allocation.
- If your child has an **Education, Health and Care (EHC) plan** please speak to the Statutory SEN Service (01872 324242) if you have any queries about starting school.

Child born between 1 September and 31 December 2019

Compulsory school age from January 2025

You can defer the school place until **January 2025** – the school place will be held for you once you let the school know.

Child born between 1 January and 31 March 2020

Compulsory school age from April 2025

You can defer the school place until **April 2025** – the school place will be held for you once you let the school know.

Child born between 1 April and 31 August 2020

Compulsory school age from September 2025

You can defer the school place until **April 2025** – the school place will be held for you once you let the school know.

Your child does not legally have to start school until **September 2025** - if you decided to defer your child's start then **the offer of a place will be withdrawn and you will need to reapply for a place in year one**. This will be treated as a new application and you need to apply in the summer term 2025. Please note that **there is no guarantee that a place will be available at your preferred school**.

Please note that if you decide to request a place in a reception class rather than year one in September 2025, having deferred the place for a year, this would be called **delayed admission** and needs to be agreed by the admission authority, usually in consultation with Cornwall Council and other professionals. When you are ready to apply

Before the deadline go to www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions and complete your online application in Parent Portal.

Providing supporting information

If you believe that you should be given priority based on a particular oversubscription criterion in the school's admission arrangements:

- You will need to provide as much relevant information as possible with your application. You can upload this to your Parent Portal application.
- Places can only be allocated using the written information that you give us.
- If you wish to send any supporting information after you have submitted your application it must be received by the School Admissions Team by the 'exceptional circumstances' deadline. After this date the allocation process will begin and it cannot be guaranteed that the supporting information you provide will be taken into account. You will need to post or email this.
- It is your responsibility to send any information that is provided outside the online application system to us securely.
- If one (or more) of your preferred schools is a school with a religious designation you may also need to complete an extra form or provide additional evidence. This is to help them determine your priority for a place under their oversubscription criteria. You should ask the school or School Admissions Team whether this is the case and provide the required information with your application.

Late applications

Applications submitted after the deadline will not be processed until after all those submitted by the deadline.

- In exceptional circumstances an application may be accepted for consideration with those received by the deadline. Examples include:
 - medical reasons;
 - a recent move into the area; or
 - a family returning from abroad.
- This can only be considered if you tell us by the exceptional circumstances deadline.
- If you think this applies to your late application please let us know why in writing.



Change of mind before the application deadline

When applying online you will not be able to make any changes to your preference(s) or details once the application has been submitted.

- For a change of preference, please access www.cornwall.gov.uk/schoolpreferences.
- For all other changes please contact the School Admissions Team.

How places will be allocated

Each school has an 'admission authority' which sets the admission arrangements. This includes the priority order they will use if there are more applications than places available – the 'oversubscription criteria'.

- Attendance at a school's nursery or pre-school, or a local nursery or pre-school,  does not automatically guarantee a place at that school. The school's oversubscription criteria will be used to allocate places.
- If your child already attends an infant school and wants to attend the nearby junior school you must still complete an application for a place – attending the infant school does not guarantee you will be allocated a place at the junior school. 

Allocation of applications submitted on time – 'round one'

If your application was submitted by the deadline it will be considered at the same time as all other applications received by the deadline.

- On-time applications are not processed on a first come first served basis.
- Sometimes there are more applications than places available. If this happens the school's oversubscription criteria will be used to decide who should get a place.
- The oversubscription criteria are summarised in the 'School details' section later in this booklet or can be found in full on the school's website.
- All applicants will be listed in the order of each school's oversubscription criteria for admission to each school. They will be listed regardless of whether the school is named as a first, second or third preference.
- If you name three preferences, your child will appear on three lists.
- We will offer places up to the Published Admission Number (PAN) for each school. The PAN is the maximum number of children that a school will admit to the year group.
- If your child qualifies for a place at more than one of the schools you have expressed a preference for, a place will be offered at the one you have ranked as your highest preference on your application form.
- Only one offer of a school place will be made for each child.

After you have submitted your application

The online application system will generate an automated email response to let you know your application has been submitted successfully.

Change of mind

- If the place is no longer required you will need to let us know in writing.
- If you have changed your mind about your preferences before we have allocated a place, go to www.cornwall.gov.uk/schoolpreferences.
- You may have to give up the allocated place and your changed preference(s) would be processed as a late application.

Change of address before a place has been allocated

- If you change address before National Offer Day you must tell the School Admissions Team in writing.
- A change of address may affect your child's priority for a place at a school or your entitlement to travel assistance.
- All address notifications received by the exceptional circumstances deadline will be taken into account when considering your child's priority for a place at a school.
- You must provide evidence of the change of address to the School Admissions Team in the form of, for example:
 - a signed rental agreement; or
 - evidence of an exchange of contracts.
- If you fail to notify Cornwall Council of your change of address and you are allocated a place at an oversubscribed school on the basis of your previous address Cornwall Council reserves the right to withdraw that allocation.

National Offer Day

- If you submit an application online by the deadline you will be sent an email on National Offer Day telling you which school you have been allocated.
- If you applied online you will also be able to log back in to the system to check your allocation.
- If you applied using a paper application and did not provide an email address we will send you a letter in the post.

When you have received your allocation

- If you are happy with the school place allocated then you do not need to do anything. The school will contact you to arrange admission.
- If you are not happy with the place you have been allocated you should look at your allocation letter for details of how to appeal and how to request to go on a waiting list.
- If your circumstances have changed since applying then please contact the School Admissions Team.
- If you no longer require the place then please inform the School Admissions Team in writing. We would strongly advise against refusing a school place until you have made alternative education provision for your child.

Appeals

If we have to refuse a place at any of your preferred schools you will have the right to appeal to an independent panel. Your letter will tell you how to do this.

- You will have 20 school days after you receive your notification to appeal the decision.
- Appeals must then be heard within 40 school days of this deadline.

Applying/appealing again

You can only apply again if:

- there has been a significant change in circumstances for your child; or
- there has been a significant change in circumstances for the school.

You can only appeal again if:

- the admission authority accepted another application; and
- you were refused again.

Waiting lists

Cornwall Council or individual admission authorities will maintain waiting lists for at least the first term of the academic year.

Children will automatically be added to the waiting list for schools where a place has been refused. If you do not want your child to be on a waiting list please let the School Admissions Team know: schooladmissions@cornwall.gov.uk

How waiting lists operate

Where a school holds a waiting list the follow terms and conditions apply. These follow the requirements of the School Admissions Code 2021.

Waiting Lists are based on the school's oversubscription criteria. This is the list that is used to decide the order of priority.

Children's places on a waiting list are subject to change. A child's position may change if:

- extra information is received about applications; or
- other children are added to the list.

No priority is given to the length of time that a child has been on the list.

The following children have priority over children on a waiting list:

- Children in care and those that were previously in care.
- Children with an Education, Health and Care Plan.
- Children allocated to a school under the Fair Access Protocol.
- Children admitted after a successful admission appeal.

A child that is at the top of the waiting list will not necessarily be eligible for a place when a child leaves that year group. If the school is already over its admission number then a place will only become available when the year group falls below this number.

If a place becomes available at an oversubscribed school it will be allocated to the child at the top of the waiting list (which will list children in the order of the school's oversubscription criteria) regardless of whether the application for that child had been late or on time.




Parents will need to reapply at the end of the academic year if they still wish their child to be considered for a place.

Change of address after a place has been allocated

If you change address after National Offer Day you should tell the School Admissions Team in writing. A change of address may affect your entitlement to travel assistance. However, as long as your move takes place after the allocation date an allocated place would not be withdrawn if you wish to retain it.

Late applications

Applications received after the deadline will be dealt with in 'round two' and some schools will already be full.

- There is a deadline for late applications in 'round two'.
- Late applications received before the round two deadline but not considered to be exceptional will be looked at together.
- If a school is already full, round two late application children will be added to waiting lists. They will be on the list with the names of children who are already on the list after round one.
- Applications received after the round two deadline will be dealt with on a daily basis but only after the round two allocations have been made. The deadline for these applications will be midnight each day.
- Applications received after the round two deadline for oversubscribed schools will only be added to waiting lists if requested by parents/carers.

Key Stage 4 schools

Studio Schools have employer involvement in the curriculum and focus on developing the skills needed for employment. This involves personal coaching and work experience, alongside a similar curriculum to a typical 11-18 secondary school.

Cornwall does not currently have any Studio Schools, however there is one Studio School in Plymouth:

Scott Medical and Healthcare College (www.scottcollege.co.uk)

Scott Medical and Healthcare College has a specialised curriculum for students interested in working within medicine or health and social care. Students join from Year 9 and study seven core subjects alongside three options.

As a studio school there is regular employer involvement in the curriculum, developing the skills needed for life as well as a bespoke Futures curriculum that enables them to become critical thinkers whilst providing curriculum enrichment around the world of medicine.

Careers guidance

All schools have to secure impartial careers guidance for all Year 8 to Year 13 students. It should inspire young people to fulfil their potential and to make them aware of all opportunities open to them. We strongly recommend that your child discuss their options with a Careers Adviser at their current school.

Applying for a place

If you decide that you would like to apply for a place for your child at a KS4 school you will need to complete an application form. The deadlines and processes will be as set out in this booklet. Please contact the establishments themselves or the School Admissions Team for further advice.

Travel assistance to a KS4 school

For families living within Cornwall and wishing to apply for a KS4 school in another local authority it is unlikely that there will be eligibility for travel assistance free of charge to the establishment. Requests for travel assistance would be considered on a case by case basis. Cornwall Council's Home to School Transport Policy is available on the Cornwall Council website. You can go to the web page www.cornwall.gov.uk/schooltransport or call 0300 1234 222 for more information.

Fair Access Protocol

All local authorities must have a Fair Access Protocol. It aims to:

- ensure that a place at a suitable school can be offered as soon as possible; and
- focus particularly on children who are vulnerable; and
- ensure that no school is asked to take too many children who have:
 - been excluded from other schools; and
 - have challenging behaviour.

It only applies to applications for school places made during the school year – ‘in-year’ applications.

The school's name, address, telephone number and website.

School type and age range

This column refers to the school's type and age range.

2023 on-time applications

This column lists the number of first, second and third preference **on-time** applications received for September 2023, followed by the number of on-time applications allocated places. It is recommended that you contact the schools you are interested in to find out the accurate details of current numbers on roll. The preferences stated only reflect the on-time applications and not the final numbers that have started at the school which may be different.

PAN 2024

This column shows the school's published admission number (PAN) for 2024 entry. This is the maximum number of children that a school will admit in the new intake which is agreed before the admissions process begins.

Oversubscription Criteria

If the number of applications exceeds the published admission number, the school's oversubscription criteria will be applied. **Please note that this is just a summary of the criteria and you should look at the school's admission arrangements on their website for the detailed criteria with definitions to understand how places will be allocated.** You can also contact the School Admissions Team for a copy of the arrangements.

Why we are collecting information about you and your child

The information collected on your school place application form allows us to allocate a school place in accordance with the requirements of the School Admissions Code 2021 and local policies.

Without this information we will not be able to allocate a school place for your child.

The Council's legal basis for processing your information for these purposes is under Article 6(1)(c) of the UK General Data Protection Regulations for compliance with a legal obligation.

Information we need

The questions on the school place application form help us to gather the information we need to process your application using the agreed admissions policies.

We strongly recommend that you read the information and guidance:

- available at www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions; or
- available on request from the School Admissions Team.

This will help you to understand how your information will be used during the allocation process.

As part of the school place allocation process we may need to refer to information that is already held about your child by:

- Cornwall Council; and
- your child's current or previous school/s.

Information we collect could include details about behaviour, attendance or safeguarding.

How your data and information will be used

The information you provide on your school place application form and any supporting papers will be used to:

- process your application;
- allocate school places in accordance with admissions law;
- consider and process admission appeals;
- populate or update our education database and allocation process databases; and
- contact you in relation to your application.

We may also use the information you provide for the following purposes:

- For the prevention and/or detection of crime or fraud.
- To follow up on safeguarding or education welfare concerns.
- To send you information on local and national child health initiatives, for example health screening and child immunisation programmes and any other initiatives that may be beneficial to your child in their new school.
- Forward planning as part of budget, forecasting and reorganisation proposals, where data will be anonymised.
- To assist in the development of policy proposals, where data will be anonymised.
- For research and statistical purposes, where data will be anonymised.

How we will contact you

- By email, if you provide an email address on the application form;
- By letter, only if you ask us to or if we cannot contact you by email;
- By telephone, if we need to.

Who we will share the data and information with

The information you provide will be shared with prospective schools during and on completion of the allocation process.

The information you provide may also be shared as follows:

- Additional information that Cornwall Council and your child's current or previous school/s already hold about your child may be shared with prospective schools. This is only where it is relevant to the admissions process.
- Your application form and any supporting information will be shared with Cornwall Council's Education Appeals department if you submit an appeal against a school place refusal.
- If you are making an application for school places outside Cornwall we will need to share the information with the relevant other local authority/authorities.
- We may share information with the Children's Health and Wellbeing Service in Cornwall Council's Together for Families Directorate. This would be to support the delivery of local and national health initiatives, for example health screening and child immunisation programmes. It may include the name, date of birth, address and school attended or due to attend of the child who is the subject of the application form. The sharing would be subject to an Information Sharing Agreement.
- Information that you provide on and in addition to your application form may be used for matters connected with your child's education. For example, school travel

assistance and school meals. It may also be used to update any other records which either Cornwall Council or schools hold about your child.

- The information may also be shared with other Cornwall Council services and professionals in relation to the Council's statutory safeguarding and education welfare duties.
- We may share the information you provide with Cornwall Council's Transport Coordination Service. This is so that they can fairly assess and award your child's current and future eligibility for travel assistance. The information may also be shared with your child's previous, current or proposed school and other Cornwall Council services and professionals. This is to help determine eligibility and/or travel assistance requirements. Some of the relevant information you provide will also be shared with Cornwall Council's approved transport providers if transport is agreed. This is for the purpose of procuring suitable transport provision.

How we will store and transfer the data and information

Any data shared outside Cornwall Council will be transferred in a secure electronic format.

How long we will keep this data and information
