Well done to **Yellow Class** who also held their Explorer Exhibition at the Pop Up Shop last week.



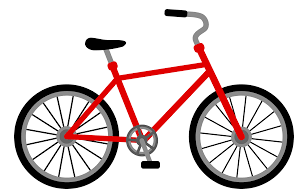
The children from both classes were excellent tour guides and showed visitors around with confidence, enthusiasm and smiles on their faces.

Orange Class children have been lucky enough to take part in a course of Bikeability Balance lessons over the past six weeks.



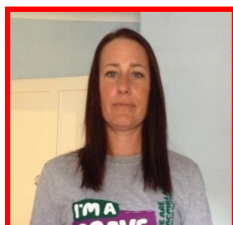
The aim of these sessions is to help teach the children to gain balance and confidence on a bike before they move onto pedals.
