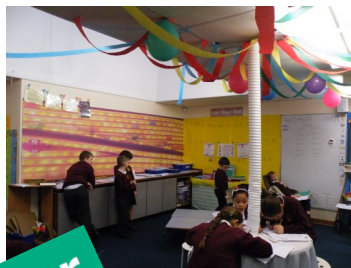

Parents are welcome to show their support and are asked to report straight to the 3G pitches upon arrival.

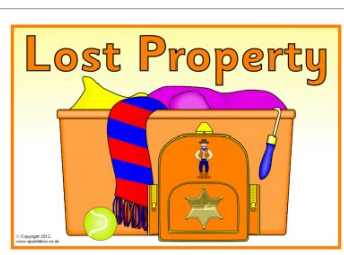


Lost Property
