<p>Read and review a war based book e.g. Friend or Foe, Goodnight Mr Tom, War Boy, The Amazing Story of Adolphus Tips (we have some of these in school!)</p> <p>(3 - 4 hours)</p>	<p>Make a newspaper report of a bombing on your street.</p> <p>(1-2 hours)</p>	<p>Draw a map of the world. Colour countries which were involved in WW2. Can you also show a timeline of when they became involved with the war?</p> <p>(1-2 hours)</p>	<p>Make an air raid shelter/Anderson shelter. Think about which materials would be best to use.</p> <p>(1-2 hours)</p>	<p>Find out about a person who was involved with the war—this might be a family relative.
