### Charlie and the Chocolate Factory

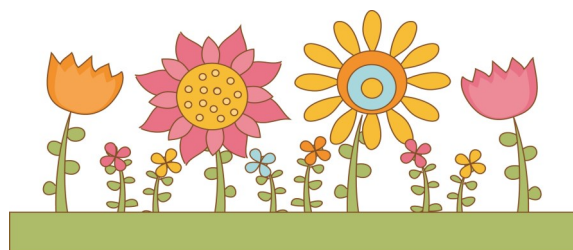
