Violet Class: Spring Term Do You Live To The Extreme?

Throughout this term, Violet Class will be going to extreme lengths to discover the Earth's severest and most punishing environments. They will explore the farthest reaches of our planet to uncover the secrets that lie beneath the Earth's surface and locate areas of the world where people and animals are dramatically affected by a variety of climates and extreme surroundings. They will identify how the world responds to natural disasters and how communities cope with having to rebuild their lives following such catastrophes, looking at the work of local charity—Shelterbox. As part of the journey, the children will complete written work (short stories, fictitious reports based on real life events and poetry) and produce artwork inspired by their learning, for example replicating the famous Great Wave artwork by the Japanese artist, Hokusai.
