Class Dojo

Dear Parents,

This year, classes in Years 1-6 are using 'Class Dojo.' Class Dojo is a classroom communication app used to share information between parents and teachers. Teachers are able to post information and share moments captured in the classroom (details of activities, including photos, that might be of interest) as well as being able to post details of upcoming events or important reminders. Parents, in turn, can comment on teachers' posts and share moments captured at home - this might include photos of children engaging in homework tasks or taking part in sporting activities.

Class Dojo is further used in the classroom as a reward system when children demonstrate one of the school's 5R values (Responsibility, Resilience, Relating, Resourcefulness and Reflectiveness) and/or their class rules.

You should have already received an invitation to join Class Dojo which includes details on how to sign up. If, however, you need another copy, please inform your child's teacher and they will be happy to give you the details again. Please take just a few moments to join the Heamoor School Class Dojo community and you will be immediately 'connected' to your child's classroom.
