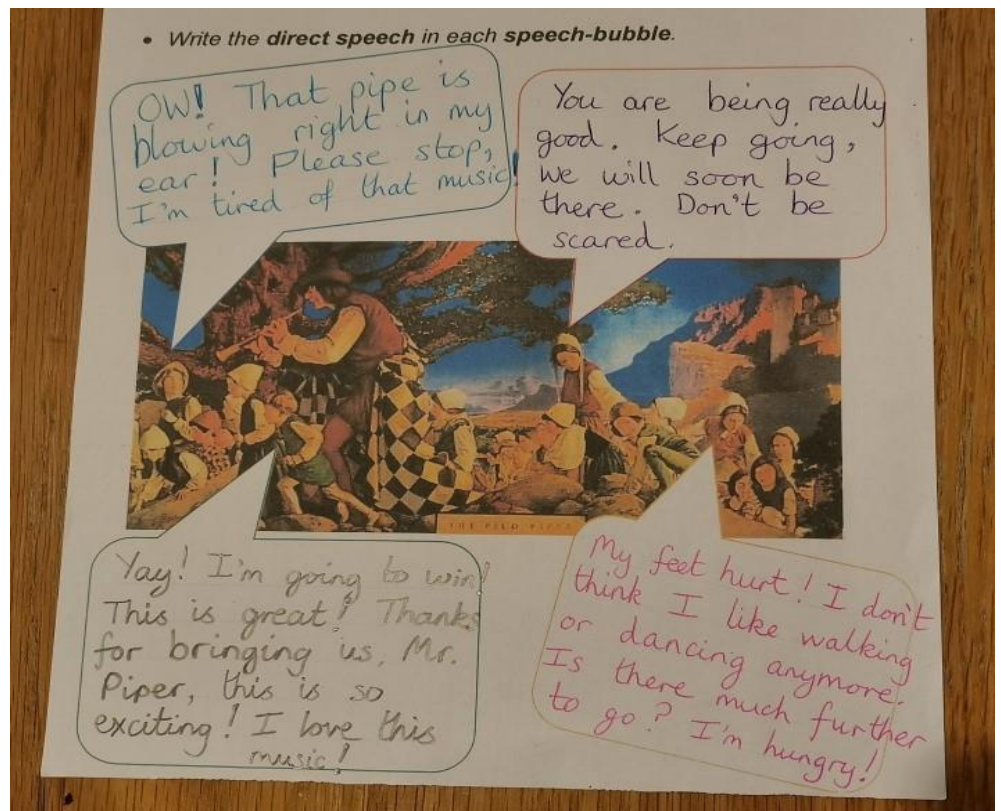


Last Week:

Task: To write a letter from a character in the story.

Each character would have their own feelings about what is happening to them.

Choose a child from the picture, and imagine you get a chance to write a letter to someone back at home. You may write this in your books.

Remember to include:

Time Prepositions
(time connectives)
First, Next, After a while, During the night...

-Place Prepositions
(behind, over, past, towards)

-Verbs (doing words)
Write about your actions. What have you done?

-Feelings
Let the reader know how you feel
happy, sad, excited...

-Question ?
There are lots of things that your character isn't sure about! Ask the reader a question (or several).
What, Why, How, When...?

-Instruction
Tell the reader to do something.
You must phrase the instructions carefully (make sense).
have to..., must..., need to..., essential...,
