Save the Children CHRISTMAS JUMPER DAY

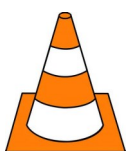
Thank you to everyone who took part in Christmas Jumper Day we raised an amazing £157.

Cornish Treasure Quest

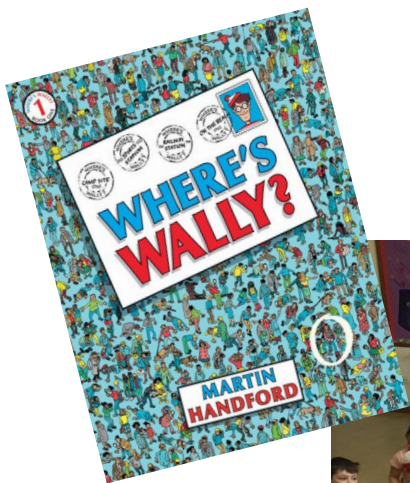


Well done to the children who earned their 'Cornish Passport' at the weekend by completing the Cornish Treasure Quest in Penzance.

.... on World Book Day?

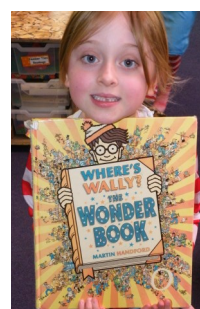
What a fantastic display of Wally's and Wanda's to celebrate the thirty year anniversary of Where's Wally on World Book Day.
