



## Home Learning Grid - Year 3

Read/Research it	Write it	Paint it	Build it	Do it
Interview an adult and find out what life was like when they were a child.	Review all of the topics we have covered in Year 3: Our World, Bronze Age, Romans and Ancient Egypt. Which has been your favourite and <b>why</b> ?	Gaze up into the sky and create some pictures of the clouds that you can see.	Can you make something new from something old? Be creative!	Learn a new life skill. Learn how to tie your shoelaces by yourself, or how to tell the time.
Learn how to count to 10 in Cornish.	Keep a diary of your time off school.	Write your name in graffiti art.	Using recyclable materials, see if you can make your own musical instrument.	Create an Egyptian god/goddess. What do they look like? What is their power?
Find out about the history of a monument/building/statue in Cornwall.	Try a board game that you've never tried before. Write a short paragraph to review the activity.	Decorate an egg for Easter!	Gather leaves and create your own leaf print picture.	Working with an adult, make a cup of tea/coffee. Talk about what happens as the hot water is added. Draw a diagram of this, showing the key changes.
Research an animal of your choice. Write down <b>5</b> interesting facts you find.	Each weekday, write out and chant your 3, 4, 5, 8 times tables (remember to write the calculation e.g. <b>4 x 5 = 20</b> ).	Shadow drawing. Get a piece of paper and an object e.g. a toy dinosaur. Place these in the sunshine so the shadow reflects on the paper and get drawing!	Make an Easter bonnet and find out why people wore them.	Bird watch for 15 minutes (or more) and record down what you see.
Read a book you wouldn't normally choose. Did it surprise you?	Design a healthy family menu for the day. What should everyone eat? Will it be expensive?	Look in the mirror, then draw a self portrait. Remember to include all of your features.	Create a set of animal Top Trump cards. They can be made up animals if you would prefer.
