### **Monday 24th June**

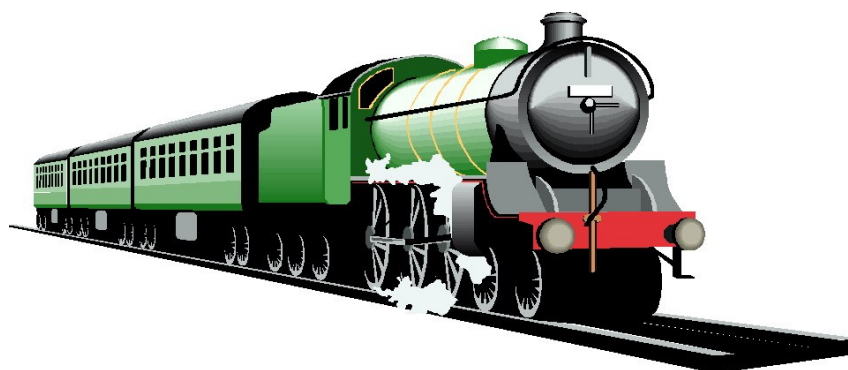

# **Itinerary**

## **Day 1 (Monday 24th June)**

Arrive at Penzance Train Station for 08:30. Parents say goodbye to children and leave by 08:40 to enable register to be taken and get organised on the train. (remember to bring a packed lunch and drink bottle) Train departs at 09:00.

Arrive in London at 14:01. Catch the Tube and then walk to St Paul's YHA.

Evening meal will be at TGI Friday's in Leicester Square.

Evening attraction will be a trip on the London Eye.

## **Day 2 (Tuesday 25th June)**

Travel on the Underground to the Houses of Parliament for a tour and workshop.

This will be followed by a visit to Madame Tussauds in the afternoon and, if time permits, a trip to Hamley's Toy Store.

Evening meal will be at The Rainforest Café on Shaftsbury Avenue.

Evening attraction will be going to the Lego and M&M stores in Leicester Square and visiting Trafalgar Square.

## **Day 3 (Wednesday 26th June)**

The morning will be spent at The Natural History Museum.

In the afternoon we will visit Buckingham Palace followed by a walking tour of Whitehall, Downing Street, Horse Guard's Parade and the Embankment.

Evening meal will be at Belgo Centraal in Covent Garden.

Evening attraction will be watching "School of Rock" at the Gillian Lynne Theatre.

## **Day 4 (Thursday 27th June)**

The morning will be spent in Covent Garden watching the street performers and visiting the shops. Then travel back to the YHA to collect luggage. Catch the tube to Paddington for the 14:03 to Penzance, arriving at 19:32.

# **Kit List**



Bedding is provided and includes a duvet, duvet cover, sheet, pillows and pillow cases.
