### Harvest Festival



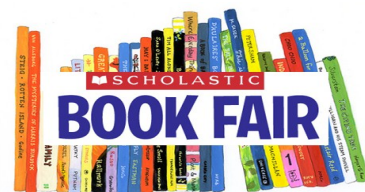
Huge thanks to everyone who helped out by sending in cake donations for Harvest this year.
