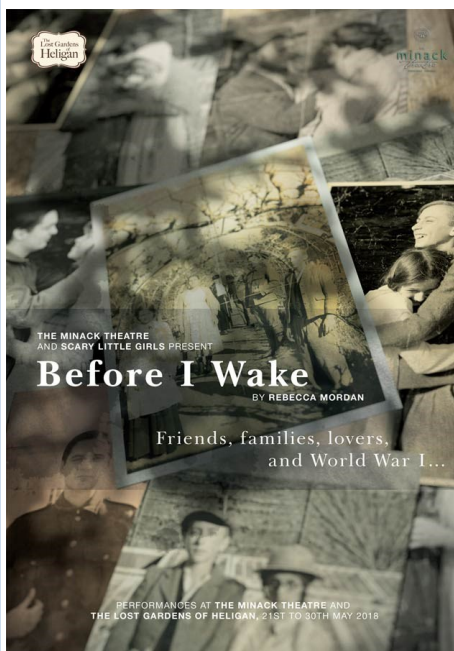


Shout out to our budding actors!

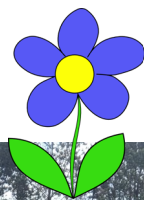
HUGE shout out to Year 6!
