Daily Activity Attend the live phonics sessions every day at 10.30am. Join in with the session, reading and writing our new sound of the day. <u>Daily Activity</u> Read your school reading books every day. Make sure you read every day at home, filling out the reading log as you go.	Ask an adult to help you find a recipe to make a Gingerbread Man. Once you have found the ingredients you need, write your ingredients on a shopping list for your adult to buy. *Worksheet on the literacy page* Rhyming words sound the same. Work through the rhyme matching worksheet.	Design the most delicious Gingerbread Man. *Worksheet on the literacy page* Using your instructions, bake your very own Gingerbread Man. Once it is cool, decorate it with a face and some buttons.	<u>Daily activity</u> Use the Gingerbread Man addition laminated sheet that was in your maths packs. Take out 10 counters and make up some different number sentences using these counters. (Make sure your answer is no bigger than 10, as we have covered numbers to 10) Extra challenge— Once you have built your number sentences using your counters, write the number sentence. Count the images on the Gingerbread Man worksheet. Once you know how many there are, write the correct numeral in the box.
	Say out loud the picture and think about how the word ends, which picture matches? Draw a line until all of the pictures have found their rhyming partner. *Worksheet on the literacy page*	Make sure you think about hygiene, and wash your hands before and after baking.	If there are any that you find tricky, repeat this one daily until you know which numeral you need. *Worksheet on the maths page*
	Cut and stick the picture instructions in order. Think about how you will make your Gingerbread Man. Extra challenge—Write a sentence to go with each instruction. *Worksheet on the literacy page*		Complete the addition to 10 worksheet. Think about what happens to your number when your are adding. Extra challenge—write your own number sentences underneath each picture. *Worksheet on the maths page*
