We would also love to hear your success stories so far.</p>
<p><u>Daily Activity</u></p> <p>Read your school reading books every day.</p> <p>Make sure you read every day at home, filling out the reading log as you go.</p>	<p>Rhyming words sound the same.</p> <p>Work through the rhyme matching worksheet.</p> <p>Say out loud the picture and think about how the word ends, which picture matches? Draw a line until all of the pictures have found their rhyming partner.</p> <p><i>*Worksheet on the literacy page*</i></p>	<p>Using your instructions, bake your very own Gingerbread Man.</p> <p>Once it is cool, decorate it with a face and some buttons.</p> <p>Make sure you think about hygiene, and wash your hands before and after baking.</p>	<p>Count the images on the Gingerbread Man worksheet.</p> <p>Once you know how many there are, write the correct numeral in the box.</p> <p>If there are any that you find tricky, repeat this one daily until you know which numeral you need.</p> <p><i>*Worksheet on the maths page*</i></p>	<p>Wash your dirty dishes from your baking, remembering to ask an adult for help with any sharp utensils.</p>
