Research an artist of your choice. For example, Van Gogh, Pablo Picasso or Andy Warhol.	Can you write down 5 synonyms for big and 5 synonyms for tired .	Draw or paint a bunch of flowers. Can you add detail to every stem? To every petal? To every leaf?	Create a 2020 shield. Within this shield, draw 6 six things which are important to you: a season, a person you would like to meet, a place, an object, a book and someone who is special to you.	Choose a leaf, flower, pinecone, stick or stone and bring it home to examine. Take time to observe and talk about the patterns you see. What shapes/ colours can you find? How are they organised? Then, draw/ recreate the patterns.
