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## Last Week's Attendance

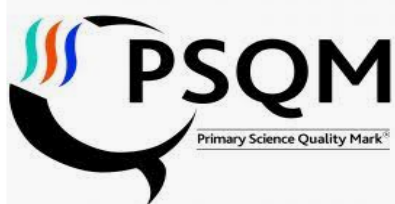
Our overall attendance figure for this term was **93.3%** and based on the Ofsted grades this would be considered

# Macbeth at the Minack



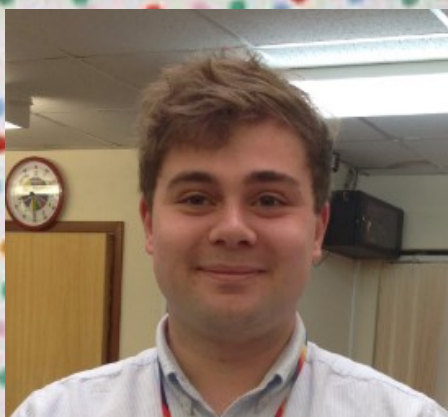
