What was it like exploring?



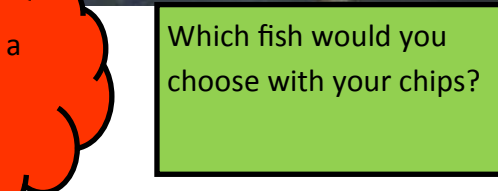

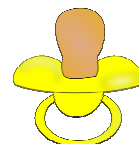
