- Find 2 sentences to describe the setting.
- Is the plot fast or slow moving? Find some evidence in the text which supports your view.



At the end of the book:

- Which part of the story is your favourite/least favourite? Why?
- Would you change any part of the story? How?
- Would you change any of the characters? How?
- Which part of the story was the funniest, scariest, and happiest? Find some evidence in the text to support your opinion.
- Would you like to read another book by this author? Why?
- Does your opinion of this character change during the story? How? Why?
- If you met one of the characters from the story, what would you say to him/her?
- Find 2 things the author wrote about this character that made him/her likeable or unlikeable
