Read up on where the Bronze Age started.	Imagine you have time travelled back to the Bronze Age. You have been allowed to take one object from the 2020. What would you take and how would you explain your choice to the Bronze Age people?	Draw a timeline from the start of the Stone Age to the end of the Iron Age. Can you include the dates of our previous topics (e.g. Roman Empire, Jesus born etc)?	What tools were used in the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Ages? Research and make your own tools like those that were used in Prehistoric Britain.	What animals could be seen in the Bronze Age? Research them and create a fact file/ poster/drawings of each. How many can you find?
Read up on plastic pollution and its effects.	Write a list of ways that you can reduce your plastic waste.	Paint your favourite sea creature, showing how it will be harmed by plastic in the sea.	Create a sea creature using plastic, card or paper which would otherwise be recycled.	How are plastics bottles recycled? Research the process and the things which they are turned into.
