

Thursday 9th July 2020 - EXAMPLE Plan for the Day

Read for ten minutes and practise common exception words!

I have videoed the sounding and blending section of a phonics lesson for each sound this week. You will find these on the phonics page. I am going to go over phase 5 for consolidation. It is important that we keep re-visiting the sounds the children have learnt so far. Today we will be re-visiting 'oi' Please sound, blend the words and have a go at writing each word.
