Design a Zoo

- decide which animals you will keep at your zoo;

- draw a map to show where the animal enclosures and facilities for visitors are located;

It must include:

- animal name:
- where it lives in the wild (including a map to show where the countries are located);
- information about its natural habitat;
- how it is adapted to its habitat;
- · what the animal eats;
- any interesting facts.

You can use the information cards to help you, or design your own.
