If you have the story, 'The little boat' ask someone to read it to you at home. (You can also watch this on the website, under Red Class, Story time, as it was last weeks story)	Draw a picture of the Rainbow Fish in your home learning book and write several adjectives to describe the fish.	Make your own rainbow fish, you can draw, paint, collage, build.	Test your boat in the bath, at the beach or in a paddling pool. Take some photos of your boat and write me a sentence in your home earning book telling me whether your boat sunk of floated. I can't wait to see!	Play a game of hide and seek with your family. Count backwards from 20—0 and then go and find them. Make sure you take turns.
