Violet Class were lucky enough to spend some time at the ShelterBox headquarters in Truro last week.

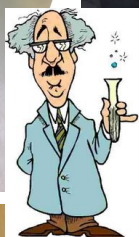
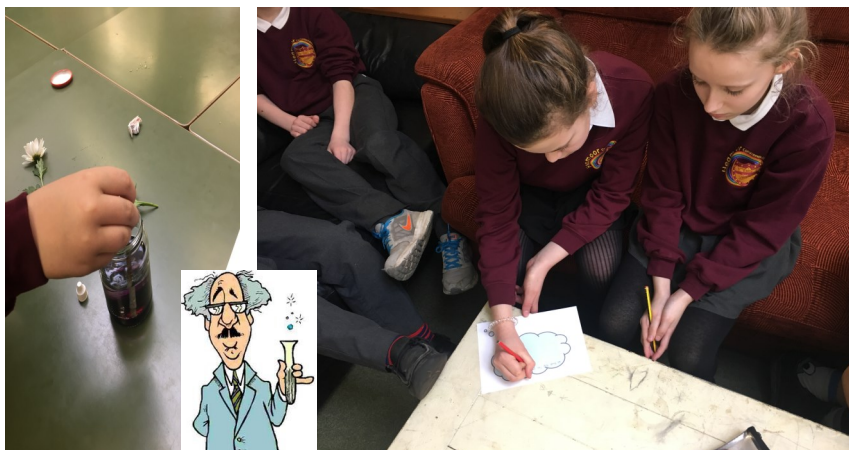

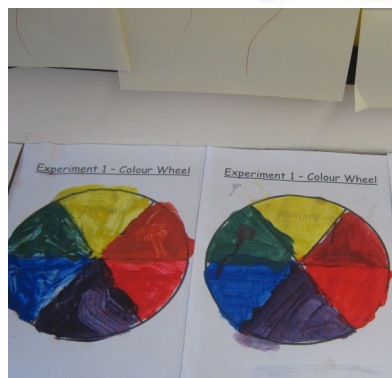
The suggested cost for this book will be £4.00 with all proceeds being donated to ShelterBox.
