Monday 22nd June 2020 - EXAMPLE Plan for the Day

Read for ten minutes and practise common exception words!

I have videoed the sounding and blending section of a phonics lesson for each sound this week. You will find these on the phonics page. I am going to go over phase 5 for consolidation. It is important that we keep re-visiting the sounds the children have learnt so far. Today we will be re-visiting 'ear' Please sound and blend the words and have a go at writing each word.

This week we will be looking at NOUNS. On the 'Writing support Page', you will have a picture a day. Write down as many as you can.

Maths is White Rose - This is already downloaded on the maths page with the videos.

Writing- This week we will be basing our learning on a short animation called 'The Clock Tower'

Please follow the link to watch this on the writing page.

Show children the title of the film. What do they think the film might be about? Pause the film throughout to see if they change their minds.

Write some questions that you would ask the girl about her thoughts and feelings, e.g. how did you get into the tower? Why did you leave? Do you have a family?

PSHF:

Use the template to make your own emotions wheel. Choose an emotion and draw pictures of what makes you feel that way.

(Eg. happy, sad, excited, worried.)
