We have also had a big focus this week on using 'kind hands, kind feet and kind words' to each other so we would be very grateful if you could further echo this message at home.

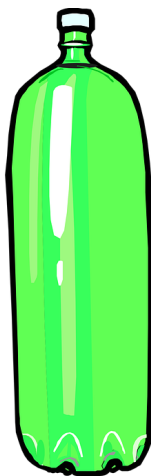


Mazey Day HELP!
