

Wednesday 24th June 2020 - EXAMPLE Plan for the Day

Read for ten minutes and practise common exception words!

I am going to go over phase 5 for consolidation. It is important that we keep re-visiting the sounds the children have learnt so far. Today we will be re-visiting 'ir.' I have recorded the sounding and blending part of a phonics session that I did with the children in school. Please sound and blend the words and have a go at writing each word.

This week we will be looking at NOUNS. On the 'Writing support Page', you will have a picture a day. Write down as many as you can.

Today we are going to look at expanded noun phrases to write a character description. (These are just sentences that have at least one adjective to describe the noun) and use the conjunction "and" to join them together. Use the adjectives you gathered yesterday to write some expanded noun phrases such as: The girl has a wide, smiling mouth. She has tiny, dainty feet. Then join them together using 'and' to create some interesting sentences which describe the girl.

(The girl has a wide, smiling mouth and tiny, dainty feet.) Draw a picture of the girl. You should have a beautiful character description.
