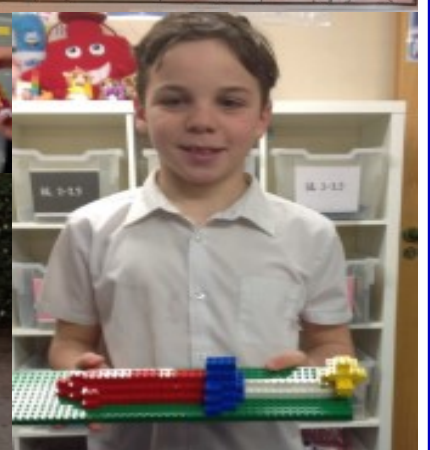
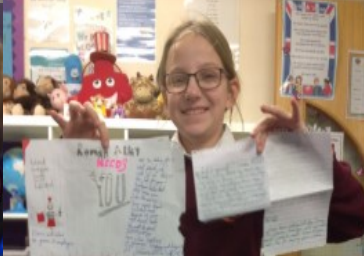


The Romans
