Managing Distractions

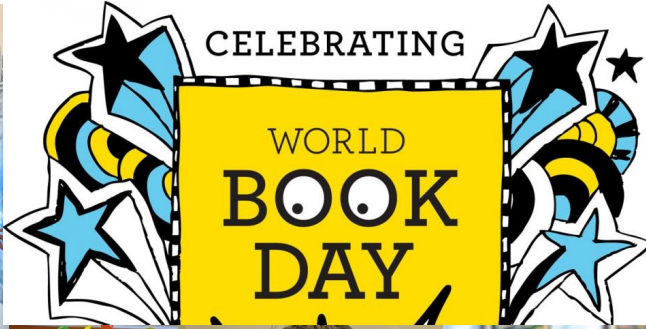
you know what distracts you, you try to minimise distractions, you settle back quickly after an interruption

Parking Reminders...

We have unfortunately had a few issues again recently with parents and carers parking in unsafe places, there's been a near miss on the road outside school with someone racing for a space whilst on a phone! Parking inconsiderately including blocking the school entrance. Please familiarise yourself with the following reminders to consider when dropping off and collecting from school...

1. In the mornings, please do not park in the staff carpark under any circumstance.
2. In the morning, use of the drop off zone is preferred but if you need to park, we would ideally like you to park on the road and walk the very short distance into school.
3. If you do park in the visitor spaces/driveway please vacate the spaces as soon as possible to avoid the area being clogged up with cars.
4. At the end of the school day; the carpark is closed from 2.45pm to all cars except staff & blue badge holders . **Please do not drive in or reverse in via the exit gate.** This is very unsafe.
5. Please park sensibly within the estate and be respectful to our neighbours.
6. Do not park in the entrance driveway, even when the gate is closed.
7. Do not park on the grass (at the front of the school).

and be aware of children moving
around as they come in and out
of school. **Keep our children safe!**



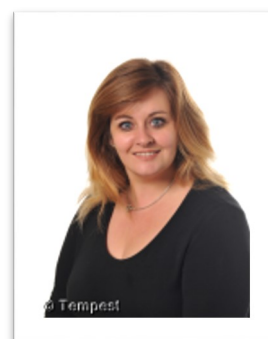
Goodbye Miss Shelley
