Daily Activity Attend the live phonics sessions every day at 10.30am. Join in with the session, reading and writing our new sound of the day.	Describe the characters from the story 'Litterbug Doug'. Think about 4 adjectives you can use to describe Litterbug Doug and another 4 adjectives to describe Michael Recycle. Remember, the two characters are very different people. *Worksheet on the literacy page*	Michael Recycle and Litterbug Doug would like a new friend to help them on their recycling journey. Using recycling at your house, design and make a new friend for them. Think about the tools you need to make something like scissors and tape and try and be part of setting up this activity.	Daily activity Make a stack of 10 skittles, using something in your house. (Tin cans, empty toilet tubes etc) Play skittles with your family, knocking down as many items as you can. Write down how many you knocked down and then let your Mum, Dad, sibling have a go. Write down the amount they knocked down. Who knocked down more? Less? Were they the same. Complete this 5 times every day. (Use your number line to help you, if you're not sure which numeral is bigger)	Ask an adult to show you where the recycling bins are. Use your understanding of materials this week to help sort out the recycling at home and leave it out for the recycling men when they come. Remember to send me a picture.
Daily Activity Read your school reading books every day. Make sure you read every day at home, filling out the reading log as you go.	Go on a material hunt around your house. Find the following items, draw them and then write what material they are made of. Box Milk carton Lego/Duplo Jumper Spoon Tin of food Drinking glass Mirror Table Teddy book	Look at the different pictures and think about the material that they are made from. Cut them out and stick them in the correct column. Even better if you make your own column and label it. *Worksheet on the literacy page*	Complete the two worksheets on more/less/ same/equal. *Worksheets on the maths page*	Imagine we are coming back to school this week and I ask you to zip your coat up, tie your shoes and do your own buttons. Would you be able to do this? If not practice one of these skills this week.
Read the story 'Litterbug Doug' to begin our new topic. Draw a picture of your recycling bags that you filled and the recycling lorry and write a sentence to go with your report. Can you see the different compartments that they use to sort the rubbish? *Worksheet on the literacy page* **This will be on next weeks grid, in case it isn't your recycling week**	Daily activity Compare numbers to 10. Get two dinner plates and choose one of your numeral cards that you have made to place it on top. Then put that many items onto one plate. Can you show an adult 'more' on the other plate, then 'less' then 'equal'. Explain your answer each time, like we do t school.
