Try and include new animals to the version you read and write your sentences in sequence. Draw a picture to go with each sentence. *Worksheet on the literacy page*	Design and make your very own story map to help you re-tell the story of The Gingerbread Man. You can see mine to help you on the Literacy page. Colour in your story map, making sure you stay in the lines.	<u>Daily activity</u> This weeks focus—numerals 6,7,8. Using your numeral cards that you made last week, represent your numerals each day using different items. You may choose to: build towers, line up teddies, park cars, make counters and then match each to the correct numeral. <u>Extra practice</u> - Ask an adult to give you one of our special numerals - count that many out from a bigger group. Try and stop on the correct numeral.	I wonder what your focus will be this week? This could be shoes, laces, zips or buttons.
<u>Daily Activity</u> You now have your school reading books, which should have been collected last week. (See letter on class dojo) Make sure you read every day at home, filling out the reading log as you go.	Give these words to your child and ask them to sound them out and have a go at writing them. sad pit mop mad tin at fog dog dock ban in sock	In class we have 'own learning' where we can use our imagination to create different things. Build something that the gingerbread man can use in his great escape from the little old lady.	Print the maths worksheet out and cut each item out and sort them into the correct column.
