Maths Ideas

Sort animals into meat eaters and plant eaters. You could use 2 circles to split them up or even a venn diagram (2 circles with a cross over part) animals that eat meat and plants will be in the crossover part.

Draw 10 lady-birds. Can you draw 1 spot on one, 2 spots on the next one and so on up to 10 spots. Put them in the right order.

Use your ladybirds to do some adding sums.
