

Our home learning tasks will consist of:

polity Reading: After a couple of weeks a reading book and reading diary will go home with you **everyday** and should be brought back into school **every morning.**

If you would like the book to be changed please write a comment to let us know and your child's book will be changed for them before the end of the day. We recommend reading the book at least twice to reinforce what they have read the previous day.

*Your child may start with a 'Pre-reader' this is a book with no words that you can use to show your child how to turn pages from left to right, to talk about the pictures and guess what might happen next and to get your child ready for their first book with words.

Everyday Maths: Encourage your child to look for Maths in their everyday lives e.g. Shape, Numbers on house door, steps.

Thank you for your support with these weekly tasks, they are not always an easy thing to do with a busy family life but any help and interest you can give will have a very positive effect on your child's progress, confidence and understanding.
