Free School Meals Provision- Easter Holiday (April)

As you may or may not be aware, the Government have decided not to fund free school meals vouchers over the Easter break however Cornwall Council have allocated funds again to enable schools to do this so they will be funded by the local authority rather than the DfE which is great news. We have been told that this will be the last time that free school meals will be funded during a school holiday though.

The vouchers will be issued to all children who were eligible for free school meals as of **24th March 2021** via the online system '**schoolvouchers.com**' which we used during the February half term. The link will be sent to the email address you have supplied so please let us know if this has changed.

I have attached a step by step guide to support you when downloading the vouchers. There is also a 'frequently asked questions' section on their website which can be accessed by the following link;

As you will have already experienced, most vouchers are received very quickly after you have selected the retailer of your choice but please allow up to an hour to receive the voucher (Please note, there can be between 6-12 hour delay if selecting Morrisons as your supermarket choice due to the supermarket system).
