What a busy week and what a lot of fun we had!

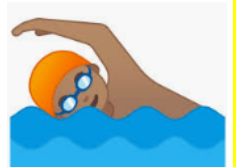
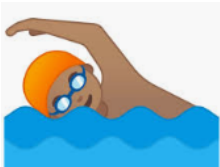

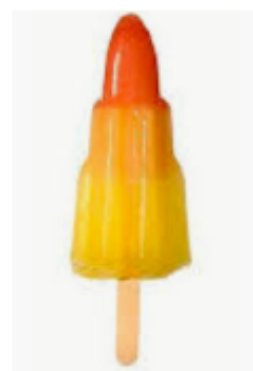
