We practised calling to the fisherman in Cornish and found out about the lives of our ancestors through artefacts from the past. We also became Newlyn Artists and sketched Betsy. Using these sketches when we returned to school, we have also completed paintings of Betsy. We reviewed our paintings and improved them too just like real artists! Well done, Blue!
