

## Terms of Reference - Curriculum

<b>Title</b>	<b>Curriculum Committee</b>
<b>Membership</b>	<p>The Committee shall comprise of at least 3 Governors.</p> <p>The Committee may have in addition, such non-voting members as the Governing Board shall appoint.</p> <p>The Governing Board may remove or replace a member of the Committee at any time.</p>
<b>Quorum</b>	<p>The quorum shall be three Governors or 1/3 rounded up, whichever is the greater.</p>
<b>Chairman</b>	<p>The Chair of Governors shall appoint a Chairman at its first meeting held in the Autumn Term of each year.</p>
<b>Meetings</b>	<p>The Committee shall meet as required and the Curriculum/standards will feature as a standing item on the agenda for all FGB meetings.</p> <p>Meetings shall be conducted in accordance with the School Governance (Roles, Procedures and Allowances) (England) Regulations 2013.</p>
<b>Terms of Reference</b>	<p>To advise the Governing Board on the school's curriculum statement, and their duties relating to the National Curriculum.</p> <p>With the assistance of the staff, to provide information about how the curriculum is taught, evaluated and resourced.</p> <p>To review the school's policy and provision for collective worship and Religious Education and make recommendations to the Governing Board.</p> <p>To review the policy and provision for sex education and make recommendations to the Governing Board.</p> <p>To receive reports from the Governor responsible for the Special Educational Needs (SEN) and to ensure that the provision for pupils with special needs are made.</p> <p>To review the school development plan annually or otherwise as required for approval of the Governing Board.</p> <p>To review information that is required to be published about results and standards.</p> <p>To review and recommend Targets at appropriate Key Stages.</p> <p>To ensure that Governors individually and collectively are monitoring and evaluating the application of school policies.</p>
