## Terms of Reference - Curriculum

Title Curriculum Committee

**Membership** The Committee shall comprise of at least 3 Governors.

The Committee may have in addition, such non-voting

members as the Governing Board shall appoint.

The Governing Board may remove or replace a member of

the Committee at any time.

**Quorum** The quorum shall be three Governors or 1/3 rounded up,

whichever is the greater.

**Chairman** The Chair of Governors shall appoint a Chairman at its first

meeting held in the Autumn Term of each year.

Meetings The Committee shall meet as required and the

Curriculum/standards will feature as a standing item on the

agenda for all FGB meetings.

Meetings shall be conducted in accordance with the School Governance (Roles, Procedures and Allowances)

(England) Regulations 2013.

Terms of Reference To advise the Governing Board on the school's curriculum

statement, and their duties relating to the National

Curriculum.

With the assistance of the staff, to provide information about how the curriculum is taught, evaluated and

resourced.

To review the school's policy and provision for collective worship and Religious Education and make

recommendations to the Governing Board.

To review the policy and provision for sex education and

make recommendations to the Governing Board.

To receive reports from the Governor responsible for the Special Educational Needs (SEN) and to ensure that the

provision for pupils with special needs are made.

To review the school development plan annually or otherwise as required for approval of the Governing Board.

To review information that is required to be published about

results and standards.

To review and recommend Targets at appropriate Key

Stages.

To ensure that Governors individually and collectively are monitoring and evaluating the application of school

policies.
