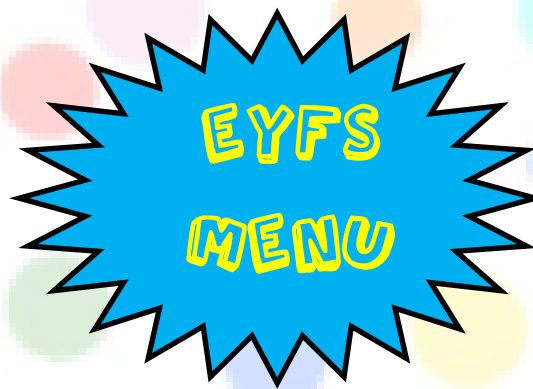
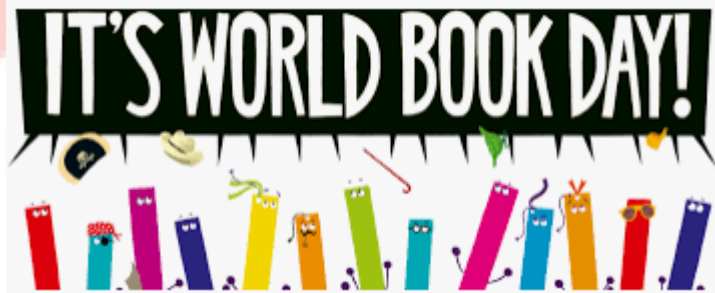

Dessert

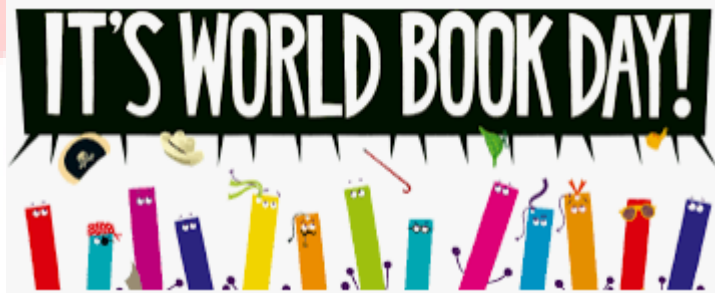
- Some baking inspired by your favourite book.

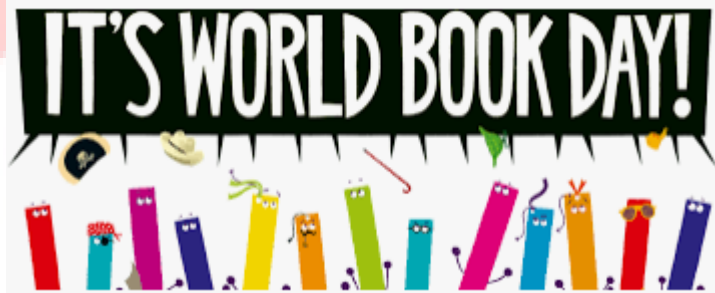

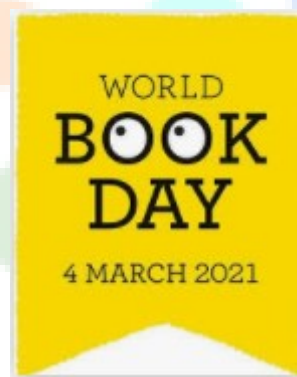

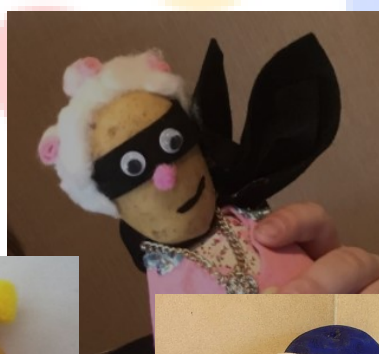
